- Bantam Pilot Model A couple were brought to Canada for testing.
- 3. Ford GP in R.C.A.F. use in Alaska. The Canadian Army had a few as well.
- Willys W-LU 440-M-PERS-1 Canadian contract CDLV-241 jeep on a Willys MB chassis. Special model.
- Willys W-LU 440-M-PERS-1 Canadian contract CDLV-505 jeep on a Willys MB chassis. Special model.
- Ford GPW in Canadian service in Normandy. This one has invasion markings.
- 7. Ford GPA amphibious jeep. Canada used a few of these. The only one known in Canada now is Reg Hodgson's in Edmonton. Your Editor used to own one which he found in Steveston!

- 8. Tracked Jeep Mark I. Armoured.
 Canadian Army development. Only
 survivor known is in Canadian War
 Museum. Mudguards were removed by
 museum.
- Tracked Jeep Mark II. TJ-2 Soft-skin, amphibious. Two survivors are known.
 Restored one in Canadian War Museum.
 One awaiting restoration in collection of Fred Smith in England.
- 10. M38CDN 1/4 ton jeep. Made by Ford Canada. A second one with Bren and spotlight in Gaza fitted with Bren Gun, spotlight and grab rail serving with UNEF (1); a third one fitted with a 1096mm Recoilless Rifle.
- 11. M38A1 with UNEF in Egypt. Fitted with Bren Gun. A M38A1CDN fitted with 4 ENTAC anti-tank missiles. (A Halifax collector thinks he MIGHT have THIS jeep.)
- 12. M38A1CDN2 or CDN3 in the Officer's Mess of the B.C. Regiment. Ask Tom Houghton for the story. White M38A1CDN3 jeep in Cyprus with UNCIYP. PPCLI flag. These jeeps were apparently cut in half and dumped in the ocean there.
- 13. Military CJ-7 (CJ = Civilian Jeep!)

(though not all come with a red nose cap). They can get Thompson SMG with stick or drum magazine, M-16, AK-47, M1 Garand, Mauser Kar 98k, Dragunov, M-4 Carbine and any of the modern black rifles or SMGs. Cheaper than deactivated guns for your military vehicle and LEGAL. One of their Thompsons with a stick magazine recently sold for about \$325 including taxes. Ask for Paul. He also comes to the HACS gun shows.
